





Except in three aspects of the feedback , teachers expressed satisfaction or consent to the present system to the extent of almost 90% -100% . The issues in which teachers had varied opinions are as follows:

✓ It is comfortable to adopt new pedagogical teaching techniques in the stipulated time period as planned for curriculum transaction: 5% of teachers expressed difficulty to new changing CBCS syllabus and pedagogical methods.


