Our college is selected for funding under RUSA (Rashtriya Uchatr Siksha Abhiyan) project, RUSA is a Central Govt sponsored programme where few select colleges were given Financial assistance our college is one of the three colleges selected in this project. A financial assistance of 2 Crore will be granted to college in future under this scheme.

Power point presentation is given for financial assistance under CPE (Centre with Potential for Excellence)to Committee for CPE , UGC, New Delhi . We presented before UGC Expert committee for the grant of CPE status which will revamp the face of college in future . we wish and hope positive results in this aspect .

Regarding the Infrastructure,

R.O. water plant was installed in college for safe drinking water for students . even staff also use the same water for drinking .

A new bore well is dug as the old bore well was 20 years old and got dried up.

All the science class rooms were fitted with Green glass boards , further Arts and commerce classrooms will be arranged with green boards next year.

ELL (English Language Lab) was established this year and two computer labs were provided to students one for B.Sc computers and another for B.Com Computers .

our college is wi-fi enabled partially. In future steps will be taken to convert entire campus into wi-fi.

Our library contains around 26000 books and subscribes to 13 journals. This year, an SC/ST book bank scheme is started for the benefit and welfare of SC/ST students. Books worth 6.78 Lakhs were purchased under the scheme and All SC and ST students are very much benefitted from the scheme. This year we received UGC -12 plan budget of 23 Lakhs of which 6.6 Lakhs is spent.

Academic Achievements of students: In spite of student strength around 2000, we have achieved better pass percentage of 42% when compared to university average.

Our students Ms . Sruthi , Ms.BhavikaJain , and Ms Sumangali won Gold Medals as University Toppers in Chemistry ,Botany and Microbiology.
